

Viktor Lehmann, 2025. Dedicated to Christin Pfisterer

2C/4C longwise set

"Shine Bright, Little Diamond"

This dance is dedicated to Christin Pfisterer. She was a member of the Heidelberg Scottish Dance Group ("SchloBDancers") from the early 1990s on. Her character was shining bright, loving, caring, and we lost a good friend to cancer on May 1, 2025. Her light will always accompany us, like a diamond in the sky.

- 1-2 First couple turn both hands half way to change places.
- 3-4 All set, facing diagonally in.
- 5-8 First lady with second man and first man with second lady turn both hands half way on the sidelines; then all set, facing diagonally in again.
- 9-16 Ladies' chain; all finish joining hands in a circle formation in the center of the set, with the men using a polite turn at the end to get there.
- 17-24 All advance one step, retire one step; then dance half a circle to the left; all advance one step, retire one step again; then dance half a circle to the left out to the sidelines (first couple still on opposite sides), keeping hands on the sidelines.
- 25-28 All set on the sidelines and turn with their partner both hands once round. Second couple to finish facing out on the sidelines, while first couple finish in the center of the set, facing up, right hand in right hand.
- 29-32 Second couple cast through second place to meet in the center facing up, nearer hands joined, to dance up and curve into first place the long way. Meanwhile, first couple cross up through top place and cast into second place, ready to start the next repeat.
