## Dancing on Water

Strathspey 32 bars for a 4 couple longwise set 2 chords - couples 3 and 4 start from opposite sides
devised by Martina Mueller-Franz - 31. May 2007

## Bars:

01-04 1st couple cross right hand and cast off one place while $4^{\text {th }}$ couple cross right hand and cast up one place $2^{\text {nd }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ couples step up/down on bars 3-4.
05-08 $\quad 2^{\text {nd }}+3^{\text {rd }}$ couples set + cross over right hands to opposite sides (and face in) while $1^{\text {st }}$ and $4^{\text {th }}$ couples (in the middle places) set + link to change places (keep facing the direction they are coming).
All 4 couples may give hands on the sidelines while setting.
09-12 $\quad 4^{\text {th }}$ and $1^{\text {st }}$ couples (= middle couples) dance a full right hands across.
At the end $4^{\text {th }}$ couple face up to $2^{\text {nd }}$ couple (which is in top place), and $1^{\text {st }}$ couple faces down to $3^{\text {rd }}$ couple (in bottom place).

13-16 All turn left hands once round.
( $2^{\text {nd }}$ man $+4^{\text {th }}$ lady; $2^{\text {nd }}$ lady $+4^{\text {th }}$ man; $1^{\text {st }}$ man $+3^{\text {rd }}$ lady; $1^{\text {st }}$ lady $+3^{\text {rd }}$ man $)$
17-24 $4^{\text {th }}$ and $1^{\text {st }}$ couple (still middle couples) dance a full "Men's Chain".
25-28 $\quad 2^{\text {nd }}$ couple dance a $1 / 2$ figure of eight down around $4^{\text {th }}$ couple, while $3^{\text {rd }}$ couple dance a $1 / 2$ figure of eight up around $1^{\text {st }}$ couple. (start by crossing up or down)

29-32 All four couples turn partner both hands one round.

New order is now: 2413
Repeat 3 more times from new places

This dance was first tried out during a small occasion in Beelen (near Muenster, Germany) in June 2007. We used a small room adjacent to the organiser's house. I subsequently learned that the wooden floor covers their former small indoor swimming pool.
This inspired me to call this dance: "Dancing on Water".
