## Examination Fever

Jig 32 bars for 3 couples set in a 4 couple longwise set by Martina Mueller-Franz - 02. August 2007

## Bars:

01-08 $\quad 1^{\text {st }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ couples dance a double figure of eight around the standing $2^{\text {nd }}$ couple.
$1^{\text {st }}$ couple crossing down and $3^{\text {rd }}$ couple dance up to begin.
$1^{\text {st }}$ couple ends up with nearer hand joined in the middle of the set (facing down), while $2^{\text {nd }}$ couple steps in on bar 8 , nearer hands joined facing up.

09-16 $\quad 1^{\text {st }}$ and $2^{\text {nd }}$ couples dance a "Half Rondel":
09-10 $1^{\text {st }}$ couple dance under the arch made by $2^{\text {nd }}$ couple, to change places
11-12 $\quad 2^{\text {nd }}$ and $1^{\text {st }}$ couples change sides, women passing in front of the men
13-14 $\quad 2^{\text {nd }}$ and $1^{\text {st }}$ couples set on the sidelines
15-16 $\quad 2^{\text {nd }}$ and $1^{\text {st }}$ couples cross back to own sides, giving left hands.
17-20 All three couples dance six hands to the right for six slip steps and then, on bar 20, cross left foot over the right (releasing hands) and pivot round to face out pulling right shoulder back.
21-24 $\quad 2^{\text {nd }}, 1^{\text {st }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ couples chase round clockwise back to own sides.
On bar $243^{\text {rd }}$ lady and $2^{\text {nd }}$ man end up facing out, ready to start the Reel (in the opposite direction).
25-32 $2^{\text {nd }}, 1^{\text {st }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ couples dance a "Reel of Three" on own sides.
$1^{\text {st }}$ man starts dancing in and up, while $1^{\text {st }}$ lady dances in and down.
